Please submit the following:

- ❑ A completed Vendor Application
- ❑ A signed copy of the Vendor Agreement
- ❑ Three photos of representative examples of your booth or items you intend to sell. Please label all photos with your name and address. If you wish your photos returned, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- ❑ Payment for the total rental of space and other items requested must be made in the form of check, money order, VISA or MasterCard. Please make all checks payable to the Buccaneer Commission. If paying by credit card, enclose credit card authorization form.
- ❑ A copy of your insurance with all appropriate additionally insured listed as stated in the Vendor Rules & Regulations OR payment for purchase of insurance through Buc Days
- ❑ A copy of your Sales Tax Permit and a signed Texas Sales Tax Certification Information form
- ❑ If additional electrical work is needed, please submit a request in writing with your application

BUC DAYS 2010 VENDOR AGREEMENT

SPACE: Space fees include a 10'X10' tented area, one overhead light and 110 20 amp duplex. All electrical cords must be provided by vendor and **NO POWER STRIPS WILL BE PERMITTED.**

DEADLINE:

- All entries must be received by April 1, 2010
- Early Bird Special: 10% discount for applications with payment submitted by February 1, 2010 - Late fees of \$20 per day apply after April 1, 2010
- Absolutely no applications will be accepted after April 9, 2010

HOURS OF OPERATION: Vendors must be open during festival hours

Monday – Friday	Saturday – Sunday
5pm-10pm	12pm-12am

PAYMENT: Payments may be made by check, money order, VISA, or MasterCard. All returned checks are subject to a \$25 return check fee.

ELECTRICAL SERVICE: We will provide 110 duplex 20 amp per vending space. Additional electrical needs must be submitted in writing at the time of application. Additional electrical is subject to additional charges.

TABLES & CHAIRS- These items are not included in your space fee. Tables and chairs are available as additional rentals and must be ordered in advance for the cost of \$20.00 per table and \$5.00 per chair.

PARKING: Due to limited space, no vehicles are permitted to be parked on the festival site. If an on-site vehicle is essential, a special request must be submitted with your application.

WASTE REMOVAL: Vendors must dispose of all trash at the conclusion of the event, including boxes, displays and trash. Buc Days reserves the right to charge the vendor any waste-related expenses incurred during this event. There will be recycling containers located throughout the site.

INSURANCE: Vendor must provide, binding proof of comprehensive public liability insurance or purchase insurance through the Buccaneer Commission at \$100 rate for the duration of their stay at Buc Days.

If providing us your own insurance, policy must include coverage against personal injury or death, property damage occasioned by reason of the operations conducted by vendor and products liability. Your policy must include **minimum policy limits of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000)** for bodily injury or death and products liability to one or more persons in any one accident or event, and **Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000)** for damage to property resulting from any one accident or event. We reserve the right to increase minimum policy limits.

Upon your acceptance into any event, vendor must provide Buc Days with a Certificate of Insurance. "Description of Operations" must read: "Listed as additional insured: The City of Corpus Christi, Buccaneer Commission, Inc., Buc Days Festival, their agents, volunteers, officers and employees as pertains to the insured's participation in Buc Days." We reserve the right to add additional insured(s) as necessary. This insurance policy must contain the provision that it not be altered, canceled or subject to reduction of coverage prior to thirty [30] days after written notice of such alteration, cancellation or reduction of coverage is mailed to the Buccaneer Commission, Inc. Please list as the "Certificate Holder" the Buccaneer Commission, Inc. and the City of Corpus Christi, Corpus Christi, TX 78401.

RELEASE: Concessionaire agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Buccaneer Commission its officers etc from all claims of arising out Concessionaires activities. If a person, entity or organization makes a claim against Buccaneer Commission (including its officers, directors, employees, agents, and or volunteers) and that organization (including its officers, directors, employees, agents, and/or volunteers) is or may be liable for loss or damage sustained by the person, entity or organization, immediately upon organization's written request, Concessionaire will take all steps necessary, including hiring counsel, to defend, protect, indemnify, hold harmless and render whole organization (including it officers, directors, employees, agents and/or volunteers) against any and all claims, demands, suits or clauses of action brought against organization (including it officers, directors, employees, agents and/or volunteers) for all liability, damage or loss, whether sought under law or in equity, which may be asserted against organization (including its officers, directors, employees, agents and/or volunteers). The obligation undertaken by Concessionaire in this paragraph arises if the claims made against organization (including its officers, directors, employees, agents and/or volunteers) are on account of injury, loss, damage caused by, arising out of, or in any way incidental to the conduct or operation of Concessionaire. Concessionaires duty is not limited by any insurance carried by either party and in the event that both parties are alleged to have caused the claim Concessionaires insurance shall be the primary policy and Organizations policy will be secondary.

BUC DAYS LOGO: No materials may be sold bearing the BUC DAYS logo, including t-shirts, without the express written consent of Buc Days.

OBJECTIONABLE ITEMS: BUC DAYS is a family-oriented festival. BUC DAYS officials have the authority to request any artist to remove any objectionable materials. This authority is at the sole discretion of Buc Days.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: The Corpus Christi Police Department prohibits the sale of the following items: fireworks; sparklers and pops, guns, knives, weapons or assault items, whether genuine, replicas or likenesses, and drug paraphernalia. Adherence to this policy is mandatory and any booth selling these items will be closed.

SECURITY: Roving security will be present during Buc Days. However, Buc Days and/or the Buccaneer Commission will not be responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items. We encourage vendors to secure all items each night at the closing of the Festival before leaving your rented area.

ACCEPTANCE: Applications will be reviewed and authorization to vend will be granted at the discretion of Vendor Chairman, Sharon Emerson. Acceptance into our vendor program will be sent to you within 30 days of your submission.

REFUNDS: Once your application is accepted, NO fees will be refunded. Buc Days shall not be liable, if, after your application is accepted, Buc Days is canceled, postponed or impaired for any reason.

Buc Days, acting through its officers and authorized representatives, reserves the right to close any artist's display for failure (as determined at the discretion of such officers and authorized representatives) to comply with applicable Buc Days rules and regulations. This non-compliance includes removal from the Buc Days list of vendors to whom an invitation to participate extends.
